As geographers, we will be looking at the 4 countries of the UK and their surrounding seas.

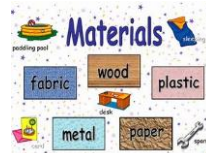


As scientists, we were learning to identify and describe the basic structure of a variety of common flowering plants including trees.



This term we will be looking at deciduous and evergreen trees.

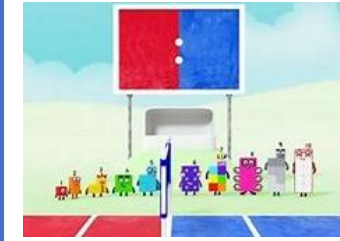
We will also be looking at materials and their properties, linking to our history topic of castles.
