## Prime Areas:

## Personal, Social and Emotional Development

## Making relationships

Children play co-operatively, taking turns with others. They take account of one another's ideas about how to organise their activity. They show sensitivity to others' needs and feelings, and form positive relationships with adults and other children.

## Moving and Handling

Children show good control and co-ordination in large and small movements. They move confidently in a range of ways, safely negotiating space. They handle equipment and tools effectively, including pencils for writing.

## Specific Area

## Mathematics : Shape, space \& measures

Children use everyday language to talk about size, weight, capacity, position, distance, time and money to compare quantities and objects and to solve problems. They recognise, create and describe patterns. They explore characteristics of everyday objects and shapes and use mathematical language to describe them.

## Children can:

Explore symmetry, tessellation, length, weight, space, balance, pattern.
Design and make structures for a purpose.
Solve problems on their own or working cooperatively with peers.
Use books as a source of information
Begin to make plans and designs
Count, order, estimate
Choose appropriate materials.
Explore concepts of strength, shapes, structures, balance and the properties of materials.
Develop gross and fine motor skills
Judge distance, direction.
Create their own environments for role play.
Create small scale worlds e.g. zoo, farm.
Build structures to facilitate other activities
e.g. ramps boats, cars.

Make vehicles with moving parts.
Discuss direction, speed.
Talk to others, discuss, listen, suggest.
