Pupil Progress meetings were held this week. We looked at the children's understanding of each objective taught during the autumn term and ways in which we can support children who find particular concepts tricky.

Maths in School

On Friday we were visited by Steve Lomax form Glow Maths. He has been working with a staff on developing the teaching of reasoning skills. Each maths lesson is now based around a Do It, Twist It and Solve It approach. The Do It develops the children's understanding of the basic maths, the Twist It tests their understanding whilst the Solve It provides opportunities to apply the knowledge to different situations. Mr Lomax was impressed with the level of challenge in school and the way that we learn "without limits."
