










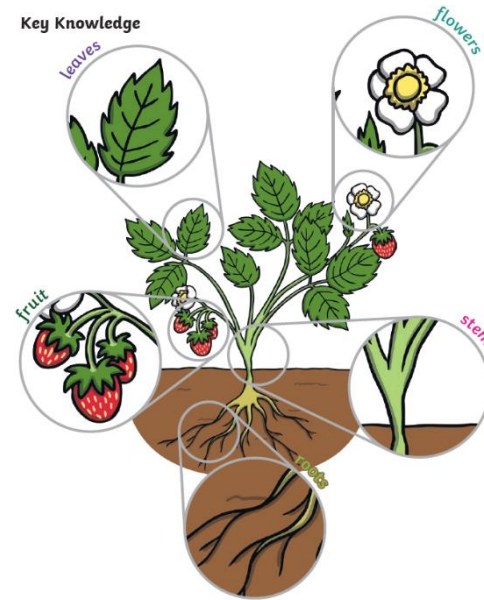
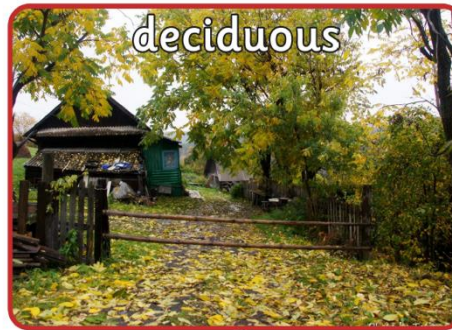


Key Vocabulary	
roots 	Roots take in the water and nutrients from the soil
stem 	The stem holds the plant up and carries the water and nutrients from the roots to the leaves and flowers
leaves 	Leaves catch the sunlight to make energy
flowers 	Flowers attract the insects and birds
fruit 	The fruit contains the plant's seeds.
seed 	Seeds grow into new plants
bulb 	Bulbs grow into new plants
evergreen 	An evergreen tree keeps its leaves all year round.
deciduous	A deciduous tree loses its leaves in the winter each year.
Wild plant 	The seed of a wild plant grows where it falls. It doesn't need to be cared for as it grows
Garden plants 	People choose to grow garden plants in their gardens. They look after them as they grow to keep them healthy.
weeds 	Weeds are wild plants that grow in places people do not want them to
