





As geographers, we will continue to look at seasonal change and weather patterns between England and Trinidad.




As scientists, we were looking at how to stay healthy and how to look after our teeth. We conducted an experiment with different liquids and eggs.




We will be looking at different animal groups this term, identifying, describing and comparing the different animals.
