Pre-school - this week the children have enjoyed lots of water play, developing their fine motor skills by using syringes to squirt objects and one another, pouring, filling, emptying and transporting the water from different places and containers; we even enjoyed a few cheeky paddles....getting our feet out and cooling off! The Preschool leavers celebrated the end of their Preschool journey with a little party on Wednesday, too.



Class 1 – we have enjoyed water play outside this week and also produced our water colour beach scenes, which incorporated everything we enjoyed from our visit last week to the beach. In Phonics, we recapped our high frequency words and in English we finished reading The Lighthouse Keeper Lunch and from this discussed our favourite foods. We then had some of these foods as part of a lovely picnic snack; this was a little goodbye treat from Miss Stones.

Class 2 – we've been busy again this week in Class 2! The children have been working hard on retelling Goldilocks and reading stories with different perspectives. We did some role play of Goldilocks and the 3 bears; the children loved this and always enjoy acting like characters from our stories. We have also been working on our art project. We have looked at L S Lowry, we will be creating a final piece to share very soon! The children have also begun a non-chronological report to share their knowledge about the Victorians.

Class 3 enjoyed their violin performance on Wednesday. It was lovely to see parents/family members at the concert - thank you. They did an amazing job and have learnt lots of musical skills over the last few weeks. We have been busy rehearsing for the end of year performance and the children joined Class 4 for the choir. Please remember to bring children back to school on Tuesday evening for the evening performance. In DT, we made flavoured flatbreads and evaluated the flavours. The children enjoyed the stringy cheese flavours and chocolate chips in sweet flatbreads.

Class 4 have had a creative week this week. First completing their free verse poetry! They were able to choose their own topic for each poem to give them creative freedom. There was a variety of topics from Christmas to Fishing and it was lovely to read all their ideas. Today has been a fun filled day with Prostar's providing a darts morning and then water activities in the afternoon – a lovely way to wind down after a busy school year. They have also been hard at work perfecting and finalising the Leavers' Play. We are so proud of the hard work they are putting in and all of Class 4 cannot wait to show you next week!
