Parking

Has your household income been affected by the lock down and the pandemic?

If your finances have changed and you receive any of the following, your child will benefit from more support at school if you apply for free school meals (even if you don't then book the meals)

- Income Support
- income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- the guaranteed element of Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190)
- Working Tax Credit run-on paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit
- Universal Credit your household income must be less than £7,400 a year (after tax and not including any benefits you get)

Search online for 'Gloucestershire apply for free school meals'. This will entitle your child to holiday food hampers if you want them, as well as more support in school. If you would like support to apply for this, please contact us.
