Dear Parents/Carers,

At the moment.....

We will continue to have multiple cover arrangements in place across Class 1 and 2 so that classes can stay open until the end of term. Children are still covering the curriculum areas planned, but routines may be slightly different such as the changing of reading books. Thank you for your continued understanding.

Please remain vigilant for symptoms and continue the use of LFTs frequently for nonsymptomatic members of your family. We are continuing to monitor the Covid situation and are working closely with UK Health Security Agency (UKHSA).

Students and staff who have tested positive are isolating. The children who have been identified as contacts of the confirmed case will have guidance from NHS test and trace and will be advised to take a PCR test. Outbreak control measures are also in place and being kept under review. The school remains open and, providing your child remains well, they can continue to attend school as normal. We will keep this under review.

Rights Respecting

This week, we have explored Articles 4 and 43. These articles were linked to how governments can ensure children access their rights and linked to Human Rights day on 10th December. In Class 3, we spoke about how the government can help some families with money to ensure they can buy food, clothing and shelter. We discussed how children can be supported through foster care and adoption, if they cannot live with their parents. Children also recognised that education is free in the UK and how this enables all children this right.

It would be great to further discuss at home the meaning of equality and how Human Rights help all of humanity, as all children have these rights.

December Holiday Free School Meal Vouchers

During the December holiday period, Gloucestershire County Council is providing vouchers to parents who have signed up to our Holiday Free School Meals (FSM) scheme. These vouchers are provided by Gloucestershire County Council as part of its commitment to 'no child goes hungry'. The vouchers are funded through COVID-19 grant funding we have received and is separate to that of the term time free school meals.

Parents who have signed up to the scheme will receive a voucher for £30 for each child who is eligible for FSM, which will cover both weeks in the December holidays.

Parents who have signed up previously do not need to re-register, they have already been included, but, to ensure we get all who are eligible, we are encouraging new parents to sign up as soon as they can.
