Significant people	
Queen Victoria 	Victoria became queen at 18 years old, she reigned from 1837-1901. She was the monarch for 63 years.
Mary Seacole 	Mary was a nurse , she was originally from Jamaica and travelled to England. She set up a hospital to look after soldiers.
Florence Nightingale 	Florence was a nurse . She made hospitals cleaner and better for patients and soldiers. She opened the Nightingale training centre for nurses. People call her the 'lady of the lamp'
L S Lowry	Lowry was an artist from the North of England. He is well known for his matchstick figures and industrial landscapes .
Isambard Kingdom Brunel 	Brunel was an engineer who built and designed railways as well as the SS Great Britain (a ship).

What were Victorian made of?	Toys were mainly made of wood, paper and metal during the Victorian age. 
What toys did Victorian children play with?	Rich Victorian children played with toys such as clockwork trains, rocking horses, tea sets and dolls. Poorer children played with homemade toys such as peg dolls, wooden boats and rags stuffed with sawdust to make balls or toy animals.
