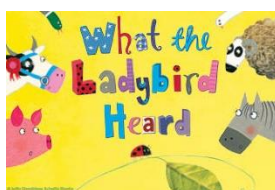
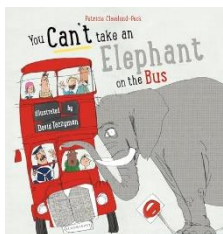


## Key Texts

We will incorporate this term's learning objectives into the children's play- lead by their interests.

**Key Vocabulary** – transport, travel, ticket, journey, growth, bud,

### Communication and Language

Patch the Dog  
Sound of the Week(s, a, t, p, i, n,)  
Letters and Sounds Phase 1

Use a wider range of vocabulary  
Use talk to organise themselves and their play  
Sing a large repertoire of songs

### Personal, Social and Emotional Development

Patch the Dog  
Talk about how we are feeling - using words happy, sad, angry, worried  
Be increasingly independent  
Develop appropriate ways to be assertive  
Following on from *Jaspers Beanstalk*- talk about patience; taking turns for resources, using timer, to wait turn to speak

We will share a selection of fiction and non-fiction texts to help the children learn about different modes of transport, growth and gardening.

### Physical Development

Yoga (Thursday pm) Dough disco,  
Forest School (Friday am)  
Use one handed tools and equipment  
Choose the right resources to carry out their own plan  
Collaborate with others to manage larger resources, such as planks, tyres, crates and guttering

### Literacy

Sound of the week (s, a, t, p, i, n)  
Daily Nursery Rhymes  
Spot and suggest rhymes in stories, songs  
To understand that print can have different purposes- tickets, invites, lists  
Use print and letter knowledge in early writing

### Maths

Number of the Week  
Daily Subitising activities 0-5  
  
Describe a familiar route  
Show finger numbers up to 5  
Solve real world mathematical problems with numbers up to 5  
  
Experiment with their own symbols and marks as well as numerals

### Understanding the World

Seven continents song  
Celebration Assembly (Tuesday pm)  
Look at Google street view and local maps -where do we live? How do we get to preschool?  
Plant seeds and care for growing plants  
Begin to understand the need to respect and care for the natural environment and all living things  
Talk about what they see, using wide vocabulary

### Expressive Arts and Design

Singing Assembly (Thursday pm)  
Explore different materials and different textures freely  
Play instruments with increasing control to express feelings and ideas  
Develop their own ideas and then decide which materials to use to express them  
Sing the melodic shape of familiar songs
