# **AiP Meal Price Increase**

Our caterers (Alliance in Partnership) have given notice of a price increase from **September 2024**. The meal price will be increased to £2.78 per meal – meals will remain free of charge to those on means tested Free School Meals and Universal Free School Meals (Years R-2). The school understands the increase is brought about by food inflation and ongoing increases in labour costs; we feel that this price still offers good value for the quality of the meals served each day.

Gloucestershire County Council would like to make you aware of changes to the holiday Free School Meal (FSM) voucher scheme that they are currently offering to families in Gloucestershire. The scheme is for children in reception to year 11 who receive Pupil Premium (benefits-related) free school meals and attend a school in Gloucestershire. The vouchers are funded through temporary grant funding they have received and is separate to that of term time free school meals.

Gloucestershire County Council committed to supporting families with 1 week of vouchers (£15) for the Easter holiday, and 1 week (£15) for the May half-term. As communicated before the Easter 2024 holiday, vouchers for the May half-term were distributed at the same time as those for the Easter holiday period. Families who signed up received a total of £30 per eligible child on or around 18 March 2024 for support with both holiday periods. Therefore, there are no vouchers being distributed in the week prior to the May 2024 half-term.

As the threshold for requesting that vouchers not received are resent, passed 4 weeks after the roll out date, we are unable to request that any vouchers for May 2024 half-term are re-issued. If parents did not receive their vouchers, please encourage them to check their spam/junk mailboxes for an email from <a href="mailto:selectcode@select-your-reward.co.uk">selectcode@select-your-reward.co.uk</a>, as well as ensure their mailbox settings allow junk mail.

Any future vouchers issued by the scheme will be communicated to schools via email, the Schoolsnet bulletin board and via our website nearer the time.
