Internet Safety – "Siren Head"

We have been made aware of a game that some of the children in school are playing at home. Please could you ensure you check any computer games that your child may encounter, because even with Parental Controls the games can still be accessed. It is quite simple to search for advice as I have done here for "Siren Head".

The iTunes Store rates the app as **12+** (advising of "mild/infrequent horror/fear themes"), while the PEGI rating for Android is just 3+, which means that very young children might be able to download and play the game even with parental controls activated on their device or through Google Play.
